Dr. Andrej Božič (1981) graduated in 2007 from the Department of Philosophy and the Department of Comparative Literature and Literary Theory (Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana); for his graduate thesis he received the Prešeren prize for students of the Faculty of Arts. In 2014, he obtained a doctoral degree in the field of literary sciences. He has published scientific and expert papers as well as translations in the journals *Phainomena*, *Primerjalna književnost*, *Nova revija* and *Apokalipsa*, and has also participated in a number of national and international conferences, as well as written numerous literary reviews. He is a member and the secretary of the Editorial Board of the journal *Phainomena*, and a member of the Editorial Board of the magazine *Apokalipsa*. Since 2008, he has been employed as a researcher at the Institute Nova Revija for the Humanities (between 2008 and 2013, as a junior research fellow). The focal fields of his interests are philosophy (hermeneutics and phenomenology) and poetry, in their relation essentially linked by the question of language.
