

## JOŽEF MUHOVIČ

### CURRICULUM VITAE

**Prof. Dr. Jožef Muhovič** (1954) graduated from the Academy of Fine Arts in Ljubljana in 1977. In 1980, he finished the specialization course in painting under Janez Bernik, and in 1981 also in printmaking under Bogdan Borčič. He also studied philosophy at the Faculty of Arts in Ljubljana, where he completed his master's degree in 1981 and his doctoral degree in 1986. In the years 1993–1996, he continued education with post-doctoral studies in Germany as a scholar of the Humboldt Institute (Alexander von Humboldt Stiftung) at the universities in Magdeburg (W. Welsch) and Berlin (A. Wellmer). He is full professor of art theory at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design of the University of Ljubljana (since 1998). He deals with painting, printmaking, and sculpture; he also publishes discussions and articles about art theory, aesthetics, and philosophy of art. So far, he presented his artistic creativity at 25 solo exhibitions at home and abroad (Ljubljana, Maribor, Novo mesto, Zagreb, Vienna, Berlin, Venice), and participated at over 150 group exhibitions at home and abroad.
