CURRICULUM VITAE

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Bernard Nežmah (1961) studied sociology and comparative literature at the University of Ljubljana. In the academic year 1987/88, he worked as guest researcher with Prof. Jens Allwood at the University of Gothenburg (Department of Linguistics). He obtained his PhD in 1995 in Sociology at the University of Ljubljana on the theme of sociological aspects regarding verbal conflict communication. He is assistant professor of sociology at the Department of Sociology at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Ljubljana and assistant professor of communicology at the Faculty of Media in Ljubljana. He received the award of the Slovenian Research Agency for Outstanding Scientific Achievements in 2012. For 30 years, he has been also publishing commentaries and interviews in the weekly magazine *Mladina*; he is a frequent guest-commentator and participant in various round tables at the national broadcaster *TV Slovenia*. He was awarded twice the “Jurčičeva nagrada” for outstanding journalistic achievements: in 1996 and in 2008.
