Assoc. Prof. Dr. Andrina Tonkli Komel (1960) studied philosophy and comparative literature at the Faculty of Arts (University of Ljubljana). She continued her studies in phenomenology at the University of Vienna and at the University of Bochum. She taught at the Faculty of Social Sciences (University of Ljubljana) before joining the Faculty of Humanities (Koper) in 2002. In 2006, she received associate professorship at the University of Ljubljana, Department of Philosophy. She was the principle researcher of the project The Understanding of the Identities of Cultural World as a Basis of Humanistic Study at the University of Primorska between 2003 and 2006. From 2006 onwards, she is active as a researcher at the Institute Nova Revija for the Humanities. Currently, she is the Editor-in-Chief of the philosophical journal *Phainomena* (published by the Institute Nova revija). She is a member of several philosophical societies as well as of project groups in Europe and the USA. Research fields: phenomenology, history of ideas, philosophy of history and political philosophy, gender theory, translation.
