Dr. Neža Zajc (1979) graduated in 2002 (Russian and Slovenian Languages and Literatures) at the Faculty of Arts, Ljubljana. In 2007, she gained the master's degree in Old Russian Literature. In 2011, she was awarded the title PhD in the field of Cultural History at University of Nova Gorica. Her research work methodologically focuses on primary sources, especially on original author's manuscripts that represent a basis for further valuations in historical dimension and a special consideration of an individual contribution to the human's knowledge and culture. She is continuously researching in the libraries of Russia (Moscow, Sankt Petersburg), Italy (Venice, Rome, Florence, Palermo, Siena), France (Paris), Austria (Munich, Salzburg, Vienna), Slovenia, Greece (Athens, Arta, The Holy Mount Athos), where she analyses manuscripts of religious, theological, and liturgical content.
