

## JANEZ ŠUŠTERŠIČ

### CURRICULUM VITAE

**Prof. Dr. Janez Šušteršič** (1966) is a full professor of economics. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Ljubljana (Slovenia) while also having studied as a visiting postgraduate student at the University of Zurich (Switzerland). He has worked as a lecturer at several Slovenian public and private higher education institutions. His research focuses primarily on the areas of political economy, institutional economics, as well as law and economics. He has published scientific works in reputable international journals, such as *International Review of Law and Economics*, *Kyklos*, *Public Choice*, *International Journal of Innovation and Learning*, *Post-Communist Economies*, and *Archivio storico Italiano*. Parallel to his academic career, Dr. Šušteršič is also active in public affairs. He was the Director of the Institute for Macroeconomic Analysis and Development and, in this role, the Vice-Chairman of the Government's Reform Committee and the Economic Policy Committee of the Council of EU Finance Ministers. He was the co-founder and Vice-Chairman of the Citizens' List and in 2012, as Minister of Finance, formulated the policy of fiscal consolidation and banking crisis resolution. In recent years, he has worked primarily as an international expert for OECD and EU projects in the field of public finance management and public policies.
